AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION: Annual approval of the use and purchase of on-line courses/textbooks and/or supplementary materials for Esperanza Continuation High and Independent Study through <i>Odysseyware Online Learning</i> . This series has been very successful with our students since its original adoption in September 2014. The attached Course Listing also indicates the CTE electives available and which courses are already a-g approved for CSU-UC.	
BACKGROUND: Education Code requires that all textbooks be aligned with state content standards. Reference for this item is in Education Code 60040 through 60048. The Education Code states: <i>Materials for grades 9-12 must be aligned with state content standards and be adopted by the district governing board.</i>	
STATUS: Education Code requires local school district governing boards to approve all textbook/online purchases for grades 9-12, and to annually approve those utilized for Independent Study students.	
FISCAL IMPACT: Funds will be used from Alternative Education’s allocated budgets to purchase the course licenses/textbooks. Licenses are \$650 each, and may be used by multiple students 24/7.	
EDUCATIONAL IMPACT: By utilizing a blended online learning platform, this program provides materials and courses that support an enriched curriculum aligned to Common Core State Standards, as well as supporting 21st Century Learning, Career Technical Education opportunities, and College and Career Readiness.	
RECOMMENDATION: Motion by a member of the Board of Trustees to approve the use and purchase of on-line courses/textbooks and/or supplementary materials for Esperanza Continuation High and Independent Study through <i>Odysseyware Online Learning</i> .. Second, voice vote
