Revised LCAP Goals, Actions, & AMOs

Previously there were four LCAP Goals. The goal related to English Learners (previously Goal #2) has

BEEN EMBEDDED INTO GOAL #3.

LCAP Goal #1

All students will have a safe and supportive school culture, climate, and learning environment that encourage physical, mental, and emotional health

LCAP Goal #2

All students will graduate from high school ready for college or career

LCAP Goal #3

All students will achieve proficiency in core subject areas (ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies) as measured by state assessment data (CAASPP)



GUSD will receive \$3,279,316 in Supplemental & Concentration Funding for 2018-2019

District priorities include:

- Increased counseling (addition of 1 FTE)
- Professional Development
- Technology/Tech Support
- Intervention
- Health Services (3 health aides)
- PLC Release/Leadership Stipends
- TOSA/Curriculum Coordinator

Total S&C Funding: \$3,256,696 \$945/ADA Allocated for Site Distribution

P2 ADA: 1941.16 McKinley: \$276,667.65 (ADA 292.77)

\$1,667.18/ADA Wilson: \$538,848.45 (ADA 570.21)

District LCAP Expenditures Total \$1,402,633 Sycamore: \$424,531.80 (ADA 449.24)

\$723/ADA GHS: \$566,196.75 (ADA 599.15)

Alt Ed: \$28,151.55 (ADA 29.79)
