- Serve on the Site Leadership Team.

- Support the implementation of Common Core strategies into instruction in the department/grade level.
- Support effective classroom management techniques, and positive interactions with students within the department/grade level.
- **Assist with the facilitation of Teacher to Teacher visitations and provide feedback to colleagues.**
- Support the integration of English Language Learner strategies within the department/grade level.
- Support the creation of assessments linked to Common Core Standards by department/grade level.
